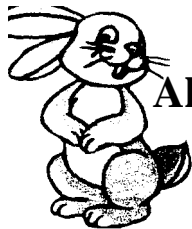


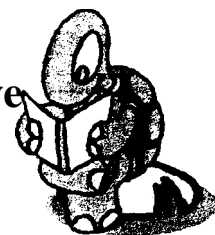

Animals Alive - Hands On - Live animal presentation - July 24 at 1:00 PM

What do birds and reptiles have in common? How do mammals feed their young? How have animals adapted to living in their environment? Join us as we explore the wonders of nature. Visit with Tina the Rabbit, Jake the Blue Tongue Skink, and other animals. 45 mins. - 1 hr. (For children 10 and under) Limited to 30. Location: By the Maple Grove Lake. In case of rain they will move into The Center at Maple Grove.

Birds of a Feather - Hands On - July 31 at 1:00 PM

A great introduction to the wonderful world of birds. Children will develop their observation skills while examining feathers, eggs, nests, skulls and talons. They will see and touch Turtle Doves and Ring Neck Doves. 45 mins. (For children 10 and under) Limited to 30. Location: The Center at Maple Grove

Pond Power - Pond Ecology - Hands On - August 7 at 1:00 PM

What lives in and around a pond? Through this educational program, children will learn about the plant and animal life of this unique ecosystem. They will meet some live pond residents - tadpoles, frogs and aquatic turtle. 45 mins. (For children 10 and under) Limited to 30. Location: By the Maple Grove Lake
